### *What is the Winnebago County Meat Animal auction?*

The Winnebago County Meat Animal Auction is an annual auction held on Saturday of the Winnebago County Fair. Winnebago County 4-H and FFA members spend several months selecting, feeding, grooming and training their steers, lambs and hogs in preparation for the Winnebago County Fair. After showing their animals earlier in the week at fair, exhibitors have the opportunity to sell an animal at the meat animal auction.

All animals sold meet quality grade and weight requirements determined by the industry and the Meat Animal Board (MAB) Committee. In addition, exhibitors are required to complete an annual education and certification program called Youth for the Quality Care of Animals which focuses on food safety, animal well-being and character awareness. The program is accurate, current and relevant to the needs of the animal industry and is appropriate for youth. Bidders (local businesses, individuals, etc.) can buy these and recognize exhibitors' hard work, but to also support local agriculture and promote their business.

Come and promote your business, while helping support the local youth in Winnebago County. These 4-H and FFA kids have been hard at work raising their livestock; training, feeding and cleaning up after them. Bid on an animal and make their year while taking home some locally raised meat!

### Day of the sale:

- ◆ Register as a buyer in Barn A
- ◆ Pick-up your buyer sign and sale program
- ◆ Join us for a complimentary buyers' luncheon on the grounds following the sale

### At the sale:

- ◆ Buyers bid in terms of price per pound
- ◆ Buyers may take a photo with the exhibitor

- ◆ If you purchase an animal, a member of the Meat Animal auction committee will hand deliver you an invoice the day of the sale

## What Happens After Purchasing?

When you purchase a steer, lamb or hog you buy the animal outright. You are purchasing the animal for the gavel price x the weight of the animal. The MAB arranges for your animal to go to a local processing plant. You will complete a form providing meat processing plant options. Animals that are purchased outright will have a separate processing plant fee.

## How Much Meat Can I Expect from an Animal?

Below are examples of the average amount of freezer-ready meat buyers can expect from each type of animal.

BEEF	
A 1200 lb live weight steer will provide approximately:	
Steaks	110 lbs
Round Steak, Rump Roast, Sirloin Tips	85 lbs
Chuck Roast	120 lbs
Ground Beef	100 lbs
Stew Meat and Misc.	50 lbs
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>465 lbs</b>
Processing charge (slaughter, cutting, wrapping, freezing, etc.) is approximately \$850-900 depending on the weight and how it is processed	

LAMB	
A 110 lb Lamb will provide approximately:	
Chops	11 Lbs
Legs	11 lbs
Shoulder	13 lbs
Lesser Cuts	10 lbs
<b>Total</b>	<b>45lbs</b>
Processing charge (slaughter, cutting, wrapping, freezing, etc.) is approximately \$150-175 depending on weight and how it's processed.	

PORK	
A 230 lb hog will provide approximately:	
Ham	32 lbs
Bacon	25 lbs
Chops	24 lbs
Shoulder Cut	28 lbs
Spareribs	6 lbs
Sausage	26 lbs
Misc. Cuts	30 lbs
<b>Total</b>	<b>161 lbs</b>
Processing charge (slaughter, cutting, wrapping, freezing, etc.) is approximately \$400-500 depending on weight and how it's processed.
